### **Routines / systems**

- Uniform please make sure your child's name is clearly labelled on all items of school uniform.
- Shoes please make sure your child is wearing black shoes, no trainers.

- Fruit free and available during morning play. Children can bring their own if you would prefer.
- Milk available in the mornings but must be paid for via the Cool Milk Website
- Water bottles Please ensure they are clearly labelled with the child's name. There are also cups available for the children to use in class.

## Reading



- We encourage reading as much as possible at home, whether this is your child reading to yourselves, a sibling or hearing a story read to them.
- Children have also been allocated a reading day where an adult in the class will hear them read their school book their reading day can be found in their reading journal.
- As your child reads, you could ask them questions about the book/characters/storyline, talk about the pictures and what might happen next.
- We really want to foster a love for reading calm and peaceful time, one-to-one or shared with siblings. (Read for pleasure comics, magazines, etc.)
- Please help your child to write at least 3 comments in their reading journal each week these will be checked on a Monday.

### **Home learning**

- Nightly reading for 10 minutes.
- Maths champion target a mental maths target for your child to practise. The target will be uploaded on to google classroom - login details can be found in the back of reading journals
- They will be tested on their maths champion the week before October half term.
- If your child has a target linked to times tables, they will have access to Times Table Rockstar to practice - login details can be found in the back of reading journals.
- Spelling will be taught in school weekly and children will be tested each Friday. We are working on the common exception words for Year 2 and revising the list for Year 1 too. For both lists see Google classroom.
- Spelling words for the week will also be sent home so children can practice.

Children have been assigned google email accounts and passwords which are needed to access the Year 2 google classroom. These can be found in the back of their reading journals.
