PYP

- **Tuesday (M2,M4, M6)- Swimming**

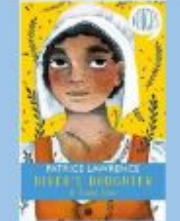
- Tuesday (M1, M3, M5)- P.E.**

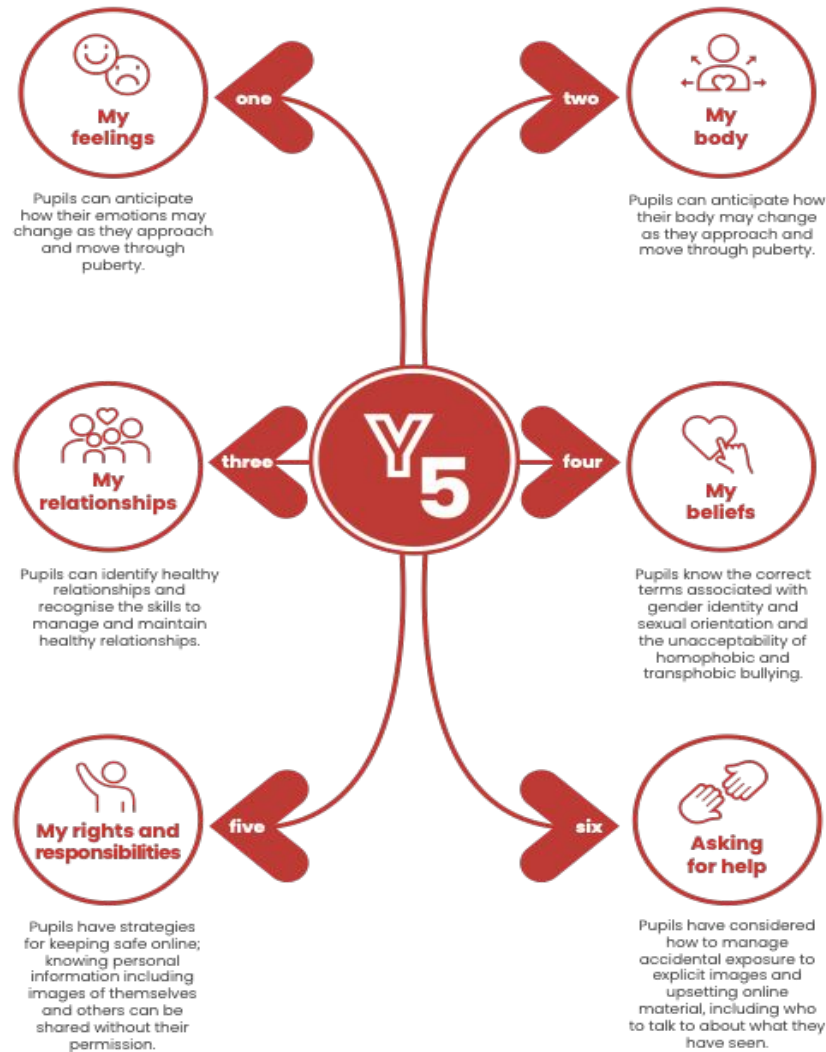
RSHE

Home learning



Reading

Reading must happen on a regular basis, at least 3 times a week, preferably daily!

It would be helpful if you read to your children and discussed the books they are reading.

Each week we will have whole class reading sessions in order to develop their reading skills.

Two times a week, children will be set a reading comment. They will complete this on Google Classroom in school.

Reading Journals:

The children only need to record the date they read, the title, and a signature.

This needs to be done at least 3 times a week.

Reading Journals are collected and checked every Wednesday.

Your child will have a personal Maths Champion target. Please practise this target regularly. Children will be tested on their targets and a new target will be set when the previous target has been achieved.



Social Media

At the start of every half term we do an E-safety lesson, reminding children how to stay safe on line and the dangers of social media.

Can I remind you that social media apps have minimum age requirements:

- Tiktok, Facebook, Snapchat, Twitter and Instagram are all **minimum age of 13**
- WhatsApp is **16 years old as of May 2018**
